By Tube

Canary Wharf (Jubilee line)
East exit is less than a 5 minute walk away.

By Docklands Light Railway

Canary Wharf and Poplar
Canary Wharf is a 5 minute walk away and Poplar is 7-8 minutes walk away.

By Train

There are Tube and DLR connections from all the major rail stations. Kings Cross and Euston are around 35 minutes away taking the Northern line and then DLR from Bank. Paddington is around 30 minutes away taking the Bakerloo then Jubilee line. Waterloo is around 10 minutes away on the Jubilee line.

By Air

London City
Catch a shuttle bus to Canary Wharf.

By Car

The drop-off point is outside the main entrance of the building and parking is accessible via the entrance on Cartier Circle. Visitor parking must be arranged through your host prior to arrival.
